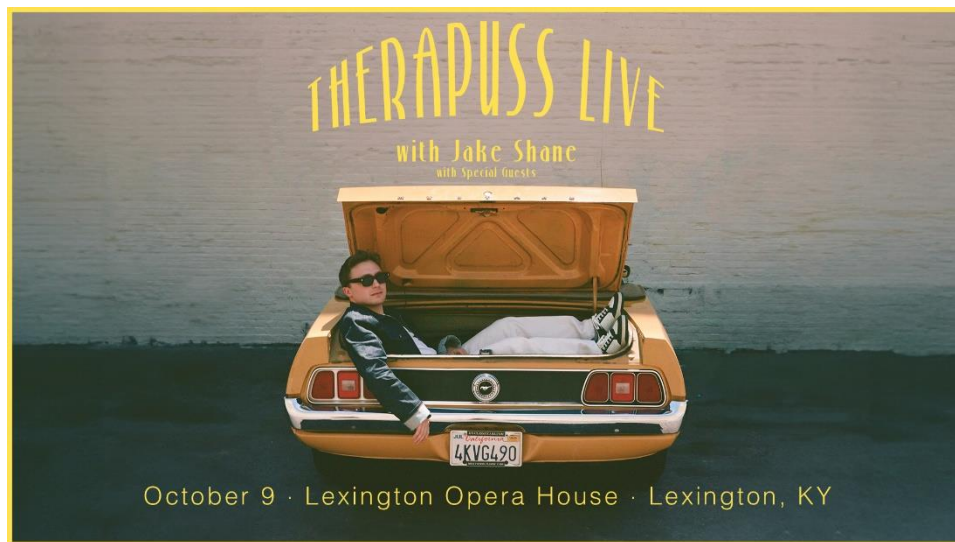

Jake Shane is a comedian and digital superstar who, at just 24 years old, has amassed more than 3 million followers across social platforms and launched multiple successful merchandise lines.
