DOGSTAR ANNOUNCES TOUR STOP AT LEXINGTON OPERA HOUSE ON SUNDAY, AUGUST 11, 2024

LEXINGTON, KY (June 4, 2024) – Today, Dogstar (guitarist/vocalist Bret Domrose, drummer Rob Mailhouse, and bassist Keanu Reeves) confirm their "Summer Vacation" Tour of the US in August and September in support of their album Somewhere Between The Power Lines and Palm Trees. The band will perform in cities including Lexington, KY at the Lexington Opera House on Sunday, August 11, 2024. The band shared about the upcoming tour: "We are having the best time out here on the road interacting with fans at these shows; we wanted to keep it going! For this next US run starting in August, we will be planning to try out some new songs as well—hope to see you out there!" Tickets go on sale Friday, June 7 at 10A.M. with venue presale beginning Thursday, June 6 at 10A.M.

The band will also offer a "Everything Turns Around" VIP Soundcheck package which includes one ticket with early entry, access to the official Dogstar pre-show soundcheck, one professionally taken group photo with the band, an exclusive VIP merchandise item, a commemorative VIP laminate & lanyard, early access to a designated merchandise stand, and on-site perks such as priority check-in, dedicated support staff, and a priority lane into the venue. With the purchase of the package, fans may also bring their favorite Dogstar memorabilia to be autographed - one item per person.

Dogstar's highly anticipated album Somewhere Between The Power Lines and Palm Trees is out now via their label Dillon Street Records (distributed through ADA), marking their first new album in more than two decades. "When we reunited to try to write some songs, we never knew what an amazing journey we were beginning," Dogstar shares. "The way this record came together was nothing short of magical for us. The fun, the passion, and the friendship shine through on these recordings and hopefully, the variety of emotions will connect and resonate with everyone the way they do for us." Somewhere Between The Power Lines and Palm Trees was produced by Dave Trumfio and engineered by Rudyard Lee Cullers.

Here in 2023, Dogstar epitomizes the quintessential Southern California storytelling rock band they've always been in their hearts, making deeply resonant music that comes from Somewhere Between the Power Lines and Palm Trees – the name of their new album which arrived October 6, 2023, via their label Dillon Street Records (distributed through ADA). Comprised of guitarist/vocalist Bret Domrose, drummer Robert Mailhouse, and bassist Keanu Reeves, Dogstar was born in 1991 as a band of friends who came together in a garage in Southern California and simply dreamed of playing music together and making a little noise. Now, all these years later, Domrose, Mailhouse, and Reeves took some time at the tail end of a historic lockdown to create this collection of songs that fully encompasses who they are as artists today. The happily reunited rock trio's official return came in May 2023 – more than 20 years since their last performance together – with their first public performance at the BottleRock Napa Valley music festival with a set that sparked fan and critical praise alike, including the live debut of their lead single "Everything Turns Around," which was officially released July 19. In August, Dogstar embarked on their 35+ city Somewhere Between the Power Lines and Palm Trees Tour, which continues across North America through December.
